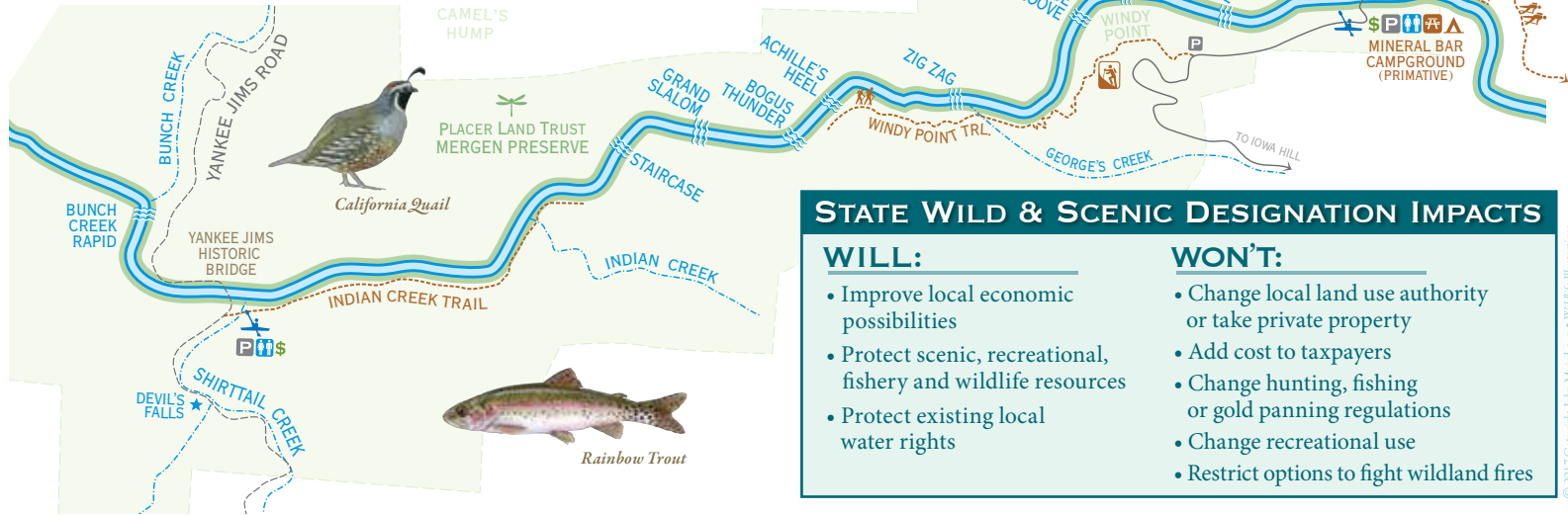

- Protect existing local water rights

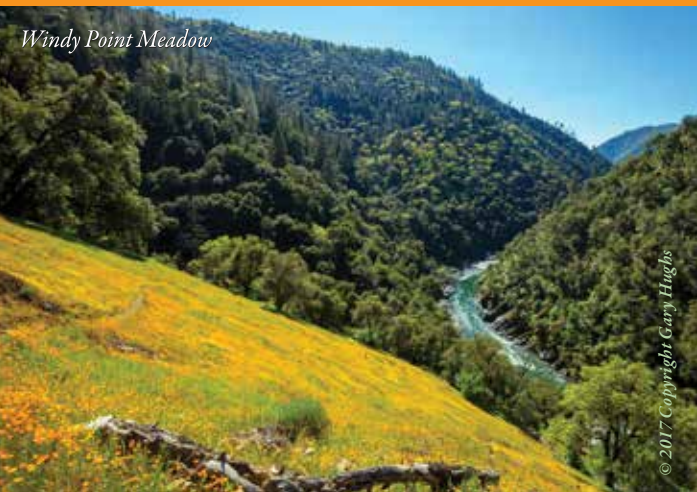
WON'T:

Protection of this pristine stretch of the North Fork, located in the Auburn State Recreation Area, allows wild, unspoiled nature to exist. It also ensures future enjoyment and access to blue-ribbon trout fishing, spectacular whitewater boating and kayaking, swimming, hiking, gold panning, and nature study in scenic

canyons that are home to unique foothill plants and wildlife.
